ORDINANCE 2007-1659

County Code Section 19.36.010 (Parking): Discussion and possible action relative to the subject Ordinance (Refer to Item No. 1086 for Public Hearing)

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, ordain as follows:

SECTION I. Recitals of Fact:

WHEREAS, the current zoning code is outdated in that the parking regulations do not address the needs of "fast-food" establishments.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors adopts this ordinance because the public safety, necessity, convenience and general welfare supports such an amendment.


SECTION II. Chapter 19.36 Parking, Section 19.36.010 of Title 19 (Zoning) Regulations of the Amador County Code is amended as follows:

One Parking space for every four seats in any restaurant, bar, or café, except that fast-food establishments with and without drive-up service, or any other high volume food service establishment as determined by the Planning Department, shall use the Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE) Parking Generation Guidelines to determine the required amount of parking spaces.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be published within fifteen (15) days after the date hereof in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Amador, State of California, and shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date hereof.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 9th day of January, by the following vote:


